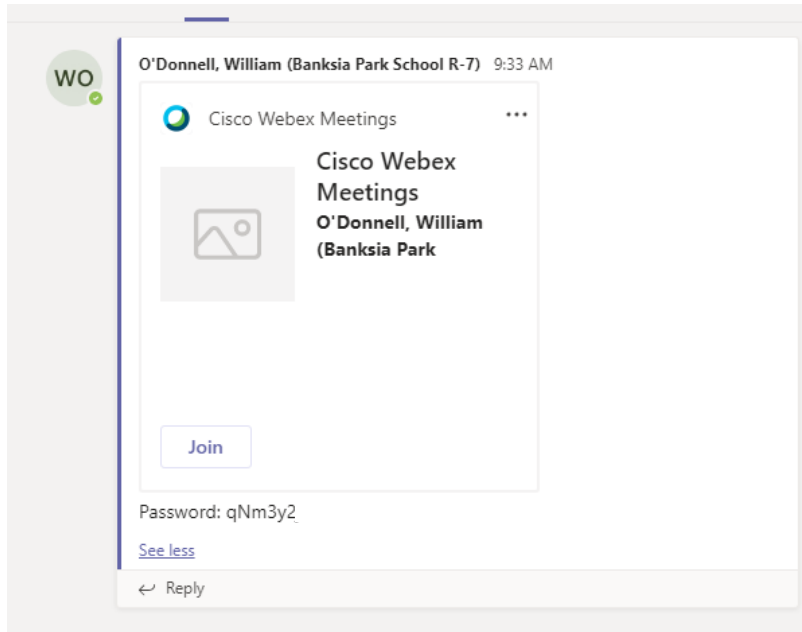


Joining Webex on your Computer

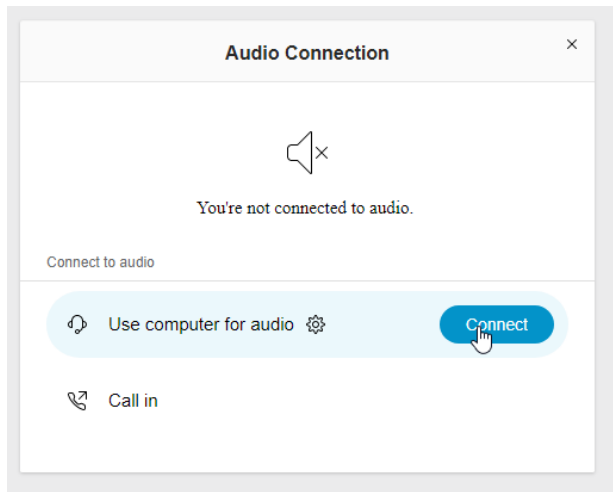

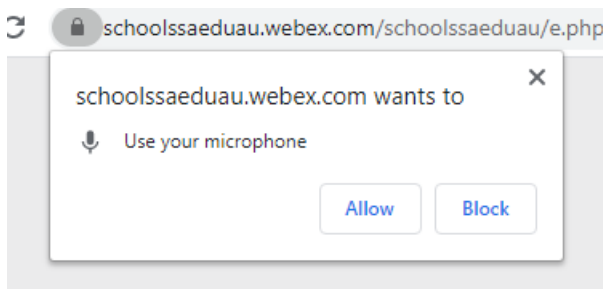


Joining Webex on your Computer

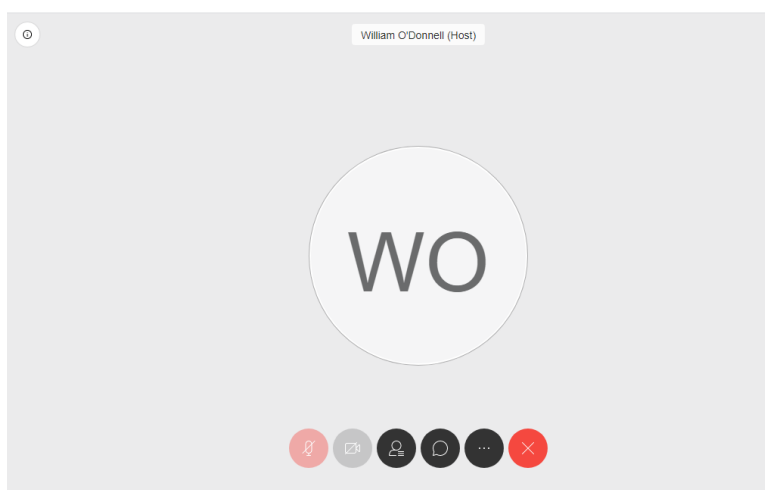
If you get a Windows Firewall prompt, click *Allow access*. You should now get a popup about *Audio Connection*, click *Use computer for audio* to use the computer speakers and microphone. If you have issues, you can click *Call in* and follow the instructions to hear the audio and speak over the phone, while following the visuals on your computer.



After this, you may see a prompt like this about accessing the microphone and/or camera- click *Allow* on these so that you are able to send your voice/camera to the session.



Now you should be joined into the session. On screen will be the content that the teacher/presenter is currently sharing (e.g. their webcam, a presentation).



You can click the small camera button to turn on/off your webcam. The microphone symbol will do the same for your microphone- however this will normally be controlled by the host/teacher.
